ECONOMICS - AN INTRODUCTION

KEY POINTS:

- * The producers of food grains are **Farmers**.
- The finished goods which are bought from the market to fulfill the daily needs of the people is called **Consumer goods**.
- ❖ The system of exchanging goods for other goods is called **Barter System.**
- ❖ The amount from the income which is left for future needs after consumption is called Savings.
- ❖ The permanent settlements of a group of people were called **Villages**.
- ❖ The early people mostly choose their settlements near **River** places.
- * The major occupation of early people were mostly **Hunting**.
- ❖ The early people made their permanent settlements near rivers to Cultivate Crops.
- **Agriculture** remains to be the root of our economy even today.
- **Man** has no limits for his demand and desire.
- The people who involved in **Farming and Grazing** are called farmers or cultivators.
- ❖ When civilization started to grow, people considered **Agriculture** as their primary occupation.
- At present in this modern world **Agriculture and Industries** are helpful in the economic development of our country.
- ❖ The major occupation of early people other than hunting is **Farming and Gardening.**

TYPES OF ECONOMIC ACTIVITIES:

- Our country's economy is based on **Three Economic Activities** namely
 - 1) Primary Activities
 - 2) Secondary Activities
 - 3) Tertiary Activities

PRIMARY ACTIVITIES:

- ❖ The **Primary Activities** are concerned with the production of raw materials for food stuff and industrial use.
- The Primary Activities includes
 - 1) Agriculture,

3) Fishing,

2) Cattle Rearing,

- 4) Mining,
- 5) Collection of Fruits, Nuts, Honey, Rubber, Resin and Medicinal Herbs, Lumbering.
- **Agriculture** is the primary occupation of Villages.
- **Sugarcane** is the raw material for Sugar Producing Mills.
- **Agriculture** is the backbone of our Indian economy.
- * "Villages are the Backbone of Our Country"-quote said by **Gandhiji**
- ❖ More than 50 percentages of the world's populations live in Cities.
- ❖ In Tamilnadu, around 47percentage of the people are in Cities.

- **Primary activities** are village centered activities.
- ❖ Mostly **secondary and tertiaryactivities** are city centered activities.
- People involved in small scale industries and unorganized sector are mostly found in cities.
- **Employment opportunities** are more in cities than villages

SECONDARY ACTVITIES:

- Transforming of the raw materials obtained from the primary activities into finished products through machinery on a large scale is considered as **Secondary activities**.
- **Industries** are classified on the basis of the availability of raw materials, capital and ownership.
- On the basis of raw materials ,industries are classified as
 - 1) Agro based industries

3) Mineral based industries

2) Forest based industries

- 4) Marine based industries.
- ❖ Agro based industries includes **Cotton textiles**, **Sugar mills and Food processing**.
- ❖ Forest based industries includes **Paper mills**, **Furniture making**, **Building Materials**.
- ❖ Mineral based industries include Cement, Iron and Aluminium Industries.
- ❖ Marine based industries include **Seafood processing**.
- The supporting factors of trading include Well Paved Roads, Ports, Airports and Railway Stations.
- **Banks** help in the circulation of money and boost the country's economy.
- **! Industries** produce goods and distribute them to the people.

TERTIARY SECTOR:

- **Tertiary sector** is also called as Service sectors.
- The **Service sector** serves the people to fulfil their dailyneeds.
- **❖** TheTertiaryactivitiesor Service sectors includes
 - 1) Transport,

4) Insurance and

2) Communication,

5) Banking.

- 3) Trade,
- The modes of transport in tertiary Sector include Roadways, Railways, Waterways, and Airways.
- ❖ The modes of communication in Tertiary Sector include Post, Telephone, and and InformationTechnology etc.
- **❖** Trading includes **Procurement of goods and selling.**
- **Activities of banking include Money transactions and Banking services.**
- **❖** Lumbering is a **Primary** occupation.
- Oil refinery comes under SecondaryActivities.
- Oil well comes under Primary Activities.
- Grocery stores comes Under Tertiary Activities or Service sectors.
- Collection of honey is a **Primary** occupation.
- ❖ Agriculture is a **Primary** occupation.
- The conversion of raw materials into finished goods is called **Secondary Activities**.
- ❖ According to Gandhiji the villages are **backbone** of the nation.
- ❖ The percentage of population in the cities of Tamil Nadu is 47%.
- **Economic** activities are divided on the basis of **use.**
- Sugarcane Industries comes under Secondary activities.
- **❖** Dairy farming is a **Co-operative Sector**
